10.45 am for 11.00 - 11.50 North Transept	<p>Lecture by Adrian Green, the Director of Salisbury Museum 'Salisbury Cathedral: Inspiration & Vision' Adrian will look at how Salisbury Cathedral has inspired art from the 17th through to the 21st C, exploring the motivations for depicting the cathedral ranging from the historic through to the patriotic and deeply personal. As well as featuring famous works by Constable and Turner, he will look at lesser known paintings by artists such as Henri de Cort, Frank Newbould and Kate Giles.</p>
